From Baltimore, Points North and West

Access Route 100 East, take exit 6A (Laurel), towards Route 1 South. At the next light, turn left onto Dorsey Road. Take the first left to follow Rt. 103 East. Turn left onto Douglas Legum Drive. At the stop sign, turn right onto Deerpath Road. MHA's campus will be on your left.
