# **Supply Update**



### May – August 2021 Summary

Month	Doses Administered	Community Events & Homebound Efforts	Unique ZIPs Served
May	12,429	142	60
June	13,654	294	92
July	6,506	309	85
August	11,182	401	89
TOTAL	43,771	1146	144



#### Booster Dose – Funding & Reporting Policy

- Hospitals may use program funding to support efforts to administer booster vaccinations.
- Booster doses will be credited towards original vaccination dose projections provided in initial applications for funding.
- Hospitals should report booster doses administered separately from first and second vaccination doses using the updated template issued from HSCRC on September 13, 2021.
- Consistent with the original intent of the program, hospitals should continue efforts to administer first and second doses to vulnerable and hard-to-reach unvaccinated individuals.
