- The Care Transformation Profiler (CTP) is a non-PHI application hosted by CRISP that allows all stakeholders to view approved CTI definitions, aggregate baseline analyses, and program performance.
 - Goal of facilitating CTI program transparency
 - Users will have access to aggregate data on all CTIs
- All data in the CTP and used for CTI analyses currently derive from the Claim and Claim Line Feed (CCLF) file.
 - Data will be updated monthly along with the standard CCLF update schedule once the first CTI performance period begins.
- Baseline analysis and performance period results will be made available to all hospitals as they are completed.



- The CTP is launching populated with the baseline analyses for submitted Transitions of Care CTI definitions.
- Baseline analyses for Palliative Care CTIs will be added in late April / early May.
- CTI program launch has been delayed due to Covid-19, which will impact timing of data availability for subsequent thematic areas. The HSCRC will provide updates on deadlines / data availability as the situation evolves.



All users who submitted a CTI Intake Templates to the HSCRC for their hospitals / organizations have been credentialed to view the application. For any other users that want CTP access, contact your organization / hospital Point of Contact.

- All POCs will find a "HosID_CTP-ReportViewer" reporting role within the CRS Credentialing Application
- Please Note: This report is summary level and does not require a Photo ID or signed End User Agreement form. However, to view a CTI roster within the MADE application you must have permission to view PHI within the CRS Portal, which does require these forms.

 - The focus will be on how hospitals can improve their future Intake Template selections to optimize their CTI population and ensure an appropriate number of episodes are captured
