Re: Repatriation Market Shift Overview (CY 2023)

The purpose of this memo is to provide an overview of the Repatriation Market Shift methodology as discussed in the Third Volume workgroup meeting held on September 6, 2024. This methodology is run with CY2019 and CY2023 Medicare Cost TCOC claims data that is ultimately converted to all-payer. Unlike the regular Market Shift methodology, the Maryland regulated hospitals are compared to grouped non-Maryland acute hospitals (border states and D.C.). In addition, the modeling is based upon ecmad, service-line and county due to the claims data limitations. In the end, hospitals' results are reconciled to their respective unrecognized growth of the regular Market Shift.

Staff would like to reiterate that this methodology is a work-in-progress because we are pursuing additional modifications such as the inclusion of Potentially Avoidable Utilization (PAU), Complexity & Innovation, etc. In addition, we welcome industry suggestions for enhancements, since this methodology is in the development stage.
