

Inpatient Hospital Quality Measures to be Added to the Maryland Hospital Performance Evaluation Guide

Begin to Collect Data for Discharges Effective 1/1/09; Report on the Hospital Guide Effective 7/1/09

- **Expand SCIP-Inf-1-3 to Include All Surgical Strata (MHCC currently requires reporting for only Hip, Knee and Colon Surgeries):**

SCIP-Inf-1	Prophylactic Antibiotic Received within One Hour Prior to Surgical Incision
SCIP-Inf-2	Prophylactic Antibiotic Selection for Surgical Patients
SCIP-Inf-3	Prophylactic Antibiotics Discontinued within 24 Hours After Surgery End Time

- **New SCIP Measures:**

SCIP-Inf-4	Cardiac Surgery Patients with Controlled 6 A.M. Postoperative Serum Glucose
SCIP-Inf-6	Surgery Patients with Appropriate Hair Removal
SCIP-Inf-7	Colorectal Surgery Patients with Immediate Postoperative Normothermia*
SCIP-VTE-1	Surgery Patients with Recommended Venous Thromboembolism Prophylaxis Ordered
SCIP-VTE-2	Surgery Patients Who Received Appropriate Venous Thromboembolism Prophylaxis within 24 Hours Prior to Surgery to 24 Hours After Surgery
