

Hospital Connectivity Process

3+ months

Pre-Connectivity (2 weeks) Technical Connectivity (7 weeks) Go Live (2 weeks)

Pre-Connectivity Activities (10 days)

- 1. Initial hospital meeting (1 day)
- 2. Executive orientation meeting (1 day)
- 3. Technical team kickoff meeting (1 day)
- 4. Distribution/completion of pre-connectivity documentation (7 days)
 - Participation Agreement (ADT only if applicable) BAA
 - Technical readiness assessment
 - Policies and Procedures (if applicable)
 - Privacy and security overview

- VPN form
- HL7 specifications
- Data validation guide

Technical Connectivity Activities (34 days)

- 1. Establish VPN connection with disaster failover (7 days)
- 2. Identify data feeds and assign port numbers
- 3. Define any unique hospital requirements
- 4. Hospital sends sample data to CRISP, ~100 messages (7 days)
- 5. CRISP completes mapping of hospital data to CRISP HL7 specifications (10 days)
- 6. CRISP displays hospital data in web-based browser for quality assurance validation
- 7. Hospital performs unit testing to complete quality assurance validation, including communicating any necessary changes to mapping to CRISP (14 days)
- 8. Complete and upload any necessary lookup tables

Go Live (12 days)

- 1. Go/no go meeting to obtain data validation approval (1 day)
- 2. Establish any necessary ongoing maintenance contacts/procedures
- 3. Execute Participation Agreement, ADT-only if applicable (1 day)
- 4. Go live (3 days)
- 5. Hospital checks live data accuracy via Production Piloting Environment
